**Face** (n.) फ़ेस—1. चेहरा, मुख

Go and wash your *face*.

(v.) 2. सामना करना, विरोध करना

Rohit *faced* strong opposition from his parents in his inter-caste marriage.

**Fact** (n.) फ़ैक्ट—सत्य, सच्चाई

The police recorded all the *facts* of the murder case.

**Factor** (n.) फ़ैक्टर—1. गुणक, गुणन खंड

Find out the *factors* of this number.

2. कारण, निमित्त

Corruption was the main *factor* behind the fall of the government.

**Factory** (n.) फ़ैक्टरी—कारखाना

What articles do you manufacture in your *factory*?

**Fade** (v.) फेड—फ़ीका हो जाना, मन्द पड़ना

The colour of quality cloth doesn't

*fade* easily.

**Fail** (v.) फ़ेल—1. असफल होना

Did he pass or *fail* in the examination?

2. काम करना बन्द कर देना

While we were having dinner the lights suddenly *failed*.

**Faint** फ़ेन्ट—1. कमजोर, अशक्त

(adj.) She was *faint* with hunger.

(v.) 2. बेहोश होना

When you *faint*, you look as if you are in a deep sleep.

3. मन्द, हलका/हलकी

I thought I heard a *faint* sound.

**Fair** (adj.) फ़ेअर—1. गोरा, गौर, सुंदर, निर्मल

Your daughter has a *fair* complexion.

I believe in *fair* play.

3. मामूली, साधारण

Sheela's performance in the examination was just *fair*.

(v.) Take care lest you *fall* down.  
(n.) 'Pride hath a *fall*'.

**False** (adj.) फ़ॉल्स—1. ग़लत, असत्य  
We should never make a *false* statement.  
2. कपटी, निष्ठाहीन  
Never be a *false* friend.  
3. दिखावटी, कृत्रिम  
Do you wear *false* teeth?

**Familiar** (adj.) फ़ैमिल्यर—सुपरिचित  
Your face is *familiar*, but I don't know your name.  
Ram was *familiar* with Rohit's entire family.  
(n.) Too much *familiarity* breeds contempt.

**Famous** (adj.) फ़ेमस—अत्यन्त विख्यात  
A Nobel prize winner becomes *famous* worldwide.

**Fan** (n.) फ़ैन—पंखा  
I would like to buy a table *fan*.

**Fancy** फ़ैन्सि—1. कल्पना (करना)  
(v.) I *fancy* I hear noises in the night.  
2. चाहना, पसंद करना  
I do not *fancy* gaudy clothes.  
(adj.) 3. रंग-बिरंगा, भड़कीला  
Youngsters like *fancy* clothes.  
(n.) 4. विचार, कल्पना  
A *fancy* passed through my mind.

**Far** फ़ार्—1. दूर  
(adj.) Ram's office was not too *far* from his home.  
He went *far* and wide in search of his lost brother.  
(adv.) 2. कहीं अधिक

This nut is *far* harder to crack than I imagined.

**Fare** (n.) फ़े'अर्—1. भाड़ा, किराया  
It's illegal to travel in the bus without paying the *fare*.  
(v.) 2. सफल होना  
Dolly *fares* well in the examination.

**Farewell** (n.) फ़ेअरवेल—विदाई  
I gave a *farewell* party for my friend who was going abroad.

**Farm** (n.) फ़ार्म—खेत  
I have built a small cottage on my *farm*.

**Fashion** (n.) फ़ैशन—1. फ़ैशन, भूषाचार  
Narrow trousers are not in *fashion* these days.  
(v.) 2. बनाना, निर्माण करना  
He *fashioned* the sword and spear with great skill.

**Fast** फ़ास्ट—1. तेज़  
(adj.) Life in Delhi is very *fast*.  
Walk *fast*, it is too late.  
(adv.) 2. पक्का, स्थिर  
I held *fast* to my umbrella in the gale.  
(n.) 3. उपवास, रोज़ा, अनशन, उपवास करना  
My grandmother observes a *fast* every Monday.  
(v.) My father *fasted* for three days.

**Fat** (adj.) फ़ैट—1. मोटा, मांसल  
If you eat too much you will become *fat*.  
(n.) 2. चरबी, मेद  
Do you cook in *fat* or oil?

**Fate** (n.) फ़ेट—किस्मत, भाग्य  
We can never know what our *fate* is.

**Fatal** (adj.) फ़ेटल—विनाशक, दुर्भाग्यपूर्ण  
I heard your neighbour met with a *fatal* accident.

**Fault** (n.) फ़ॉल्ट—गलती, भूल  
It was employer's *fault* that the employees were not paid in time.

The mechanic quickly repaired the *fault* in the car engine.

**Feat** (n.) फ़ीट—कमाल, करतब, असाधारण कार्य

Children were thrilled seeing the feats of the acrobat.

**Feature** (n.) फ़ीचर—1. चेहरा-मोहरा, नाक-नकशा

Who is that young lady with sharp features?

2. विशेषता, विशिष्टता

Dusty winds are a feature of Delhi summers.

3. नियमित लेख

The newspapers carry features on environment regularly.

**Federation** (n.) फ़ेडरेशन—संघ

The Federation of Indian Chamber of Commerce and Industry is headed by a reputed industrialist.

**Fee** (n.) फ़ी—फ़ीस, शुल्क

Have you paid your son's school fees?

We pay fees to doctors, tutors and lawyers.

**Feeble** (adj.) फ़ीबल—1. कमज़ोर, अशक्त

My long illness has made me feeble.

2. मद्धिम, धुंधला

I was unable to read in the feeble candle light.

**Feed** (v.) फ़ीड—खिलाना, भोजन देना

To feed an infant with the mother's milk is good for his health.

(adj.) Where is the baby's feeding bottle?

**Feel** (v.) फ़ील—1. स्पर्श करना, छूना

The doctor felt the injured arm of

Usha to see if there was a fracture.

2. लगना, प्रतीत होना

We all felt happy at the good news.

(n.) 3. अनुभव करना, महसूस करने की शक्ति

The old woman had no feeling in her numb fingers.

**Female** (adj. & n.) फ़ीमेल—मादा, स्त्री

A female peacock is not beautiful.

(n.) The female of a deer is called doe.

**Feminine** (adj.) फ़े 'मिनिन—स्त्री-संबन्धी, स्त्री-

सुलभ

The boy with a feminine look was given a female role in the play.

**Fence** फ़े 'न्स—बाड़ा, घेरा, बाड़ा लगाना

(n.) Can you jump over this fence?

(v.) He fenced his garden to protect it from animals.

**Ferry** फ़े 'रि—तारण, नौघाट, नौका, पार उतारना

(n.) We crossed to the Swarga Ashram in a ferry.

(v.) The pilgrims were ferried across the Ganges.

**Fertile** (adj.) फ़र्टाइल—उपजाऊ, कल्पनाशील, उर्वर

My farm is quite fertile.

You have a fertile brain.

**Festival** (n.) फ़े 'स्टिवल—त्योहार, उत्सव

India is a land of festivals.

**Fetch** (v.) फ़ेच—लाना, ले आना

Please fetch me a glass of water.

**Fever** (n.) फ़ीवर—बुखार, ज्वर

The doctor advised rest to Dinesh as he was having high fever.

**Few** (adj.) फ़्यू—1. इने-गिने, कुछ

A few of my friends know that I can paint.

2. बहुत कम, शायद ही कोई

Few of my friends know that I can paint.

**Fibre** (n.) फाइबर—रेशा, तन्तु, सूत्र

Of what fibre is your shirt made?

**Fidget** (v.) फ़िजिट—चंचलता दिखाना, हाथ-पैर चलाते रहना

You cannot concentrate on what you are reading if you keep *fidgeting*.

**Field** (n.) फ़ील्ड—1. खेत

What do you grow in your *field*?

2. क्षेत्र

Do you have any experience in the *field* of social work?

**Fierce** (adj.) फ़िअर्स—खूंखार, हिंस्र

I assure you my dog is not a *fierce* animal.

**Fight** फ़ाइट—लड़ाई (करना)

(v.) The two neighbours were *fighting* on a petty issue.

(n.) It was a *fierce fight* among street dogs.

**Figure** (n.) फ़िगर्—1. अंक, रकम, आँकड़ा

I am good at *figures*.

2. रूप, आकार, आकृति

In the dark I could make out a *figure* moving about in the room.

(v.) 3. कल्पना करना, हिसाब लगाना

Can you *figure* out how we can persuade the minister to preside over the function?

**File** फ़ाइल—1. फ़ाइल, संचिका, फाइल में रखना

(n.) Where is the *file* of our correspondence with the government?

(v.) *File* these papers carefully.

2. कतार, ताँता

Boys, march to your class-rooms in a single *file*.

3. रेती

I bought a carpenter's *file* for some wood work in the house.

**Fill** (v.) फ़िल—भरना, भर जाना/देना, पूरा करना

Please *fill* this glass with cold water.

Students were *filled* with joy at the declaration of vacations.

**Film** (n.) फ़िल्म—1. चलचित्र, फ़िल्म

Are you fond of *films*?

2. फ़िल्म

Is there a *film* in your camera?

3. परत, तह, पटल

Don't drink this water, it has a *film* of oil on it.

There is a *film* of dust on the table.

**Filter** फ़िल्टर्—फ़िल्टर (करना), छानना  
(v.) *Filter* this water before you drink it.  
(n.) I have bought a water *filter*.

**Filthy** (adj.) फ़िल्थि—मैला, गन्दा, अश्लील  
The house had been empty for years and was *filthy* inside.

**Final** (adj.) फ़ाइनल—आखिरी, अन्तिम  
When is your *final* examination starting?

(adv.) Ram *finally* agreed to accompany Suresh to the trade fair.

**Financial** (adj.) फ़ाइनेन्शल—आर्थिक, वित्तीय  
The government offered *financial* aid to the farmers whose crops were destroyed in the floods.

**Find** (v.) फ़ाइन्ड—पाना, प्राप्त करना, पता लगाना  
Have you *found* the purse you had lost?

On reaching home Rahul *found* his friend waiting for him.

**Fine** फ़ाइन—1. उत्तम, उत्कृष्ट

(adj.) The acrobats presented a *fine* show.

(n.) 2. महीन, सूक्ष्म, पतला

Sharpen your pencil and draw a *fine* line.

3. जुर्माना

Ramesh had to pay a *fine* of five rupees on returning a library book late.

**Finger** (n.) फ़िगर्—उँगली

This ring looks beautiful on your little *finger*.

**Finish** (v.) फ़िनिश—1. समाप्त करना, पूर्ण करना

Have you *finished* your home work?

(n.) 2. परिष्कार, परिसज्जा

Your dining table has a nice *finish*.

**Fire** (n.) फ़ायर्—1. आग, ज्वाला

Last night a *fire* broke out in our lane.

(v.) 2. गोली चलाना, दागना

The police *fired* in the air to disperse a rioting mob.

**Firm** (n.) फ़र्म—1. कंपनी, फ़र्म

I learn you have joined a big *firm*.

(adj.) 2. दृढ़, निश्चित, अटल  
It's my *firm* belief that God rewards hard work.

3. ठोस, पक्का, मज़बूत  
I jumped from the boat on to the *firm* ground.

**First** (adj.) फ़र्स्ट—1. पहला, प्रथम  
My son came *first* in the competition.

2. *First-aid*—प्राथमिक उपचार  
Always keep a *first-aid* box in the house.

(adv.) 3. पहले  
Mother asked Usha to *first* take dinner and then watch TV programmes.

**Fish** (n.) फ़िश—मछली  
Would you like fried *fish* for lunch?

**Fist** (n.) फ़िस्ट—मुक्का, मुट्ठी  
The children were imitating a fight sequence from the film by waving their *fists* in the air.

**Fit** (v.) फ़िट—1. ठीक आना, ठीक बैठ जाना  
This shirt *fits* me very well.

(adj.) 2. स्वस्थ, दुरुस्त  
I was ill last month, but now I am *fit*.

3. अनुरूप, लायक, योग्य  
The employer asked the job applicant whether he is *fit* enough to hold a supervisor's post.

(n.) 4. दौरा  
He slapped his son in a *fit* of anger.

**Flame** (n.) फ़्लेम—ज्वाला, लपट  
Before sleeping put out all the *flames* in your house.

**Flare** (n.) फ़्लेअर—1. धधक, प्रदीप्ति  
In the *flare* of the match I saw the lost ring on the floor.

(v.) 2. भड़कना, क्रोधित होना  
You must give up your habit of *flaring* up without cause.

**Flash** फ़्लैश—1. दमक, चौंध, दमकना  
(n.) There was a sudden *flash* of lightning in the clouded sky.

(v.) Why are your eyes *flashing* with anger?

2. तीव्र गति से भागना  
The cars participating in the race *flashed* past us.

**Flat** (n.) फ़्लैट—1. फ़्लैट, कक्ष  
My *flat* has three rooms.

(adj.) 2. समतल, सपाट, सीधे पीठ के बल  
Lie *flat* on the bed to overcome tiredness.

**Flatter** (v.) फ़्लैटर्—खुशामद करना, चाटुकारी करना

Everybody is *flattered* by a compliment.

(n.) The people who are adept at *flattery* are called *flatterers*.

**Flavour** (n.) फ़्लेवर्—सुगन्ध

In how many *flavours* does this ice-cream come?

(v.) Sheela's birthday cake was *flavoured* with vanilla essence.

**Flaw** (n.) फ़्लॉ—दोष, त्रुटि

The advocates try to find a *flaw* in every law.

(adj.) In a TV programme, the famous beautician gave many tips to maintain a *flawless* complexion.

**Flee** (v.) फ़्ली—भागना, भाग जाना  
We all *fled* from the house on fire.

**Flesh** (n.) फ़्लेश—मांस, गोश्त, गूदा  
You have put on *flesh* during your foreign trip.

**Flexible** (adj.) फ़्लैक्सिबल—झुकने योग्य, मुड़ने योग्य

Our arms and legs are *flexible*.

(n.) They have *flexibility*.

**Flicker** (v.) फ़्लिकर्—1. टिमटिमाना, झिलमिलाना  
The candle flame *flickers* in the wind.

(adj.) Reading in the *flickering* flame of the candle is not good for one's eyes.

(n.) 2. किरण

The marooned flood victims had a *flicker* of hope that they would be rescued.

**Fling** (v.) फिंग—फेंकना, पटकना

Both the wrestlers were trying to *fling* each other on to the ground.

Don't *fling* baseless charges at me.

**Float** (v.) फ्लोट—पानी के तल तक टिकना  
I *float* for a while before I begin to swim.

People swim, wood *floats*, but a stone sinks.

**Flock** (n.) फ्लॉक—1. झुण्ड, समूह, दल  
Look at that *flock* of birds in the sky.

(v.) 2. जमा या एकत्र हो जाना

At the fair, the children *flocked* around the toy shops.

**Flood** (n.) फ्लड—1. बाढ़, ज्वार, मूसलाधार वर्षा  
I could not go to Patna last year because of the *floods* there.

**Folk** (n.) फोक—लोक, जनता, जनसाधारण  
The country *folk* were very kind to me.

**Follow** (v.) फॉलो—1. पीछे-पीछे चलना  
*Follow* me into my room.

2. समझना

Do you *follow* your professor's lectures?

**Folly** (n.) फॉलि—मूर्खता, बेवकूफी  
It was a *folly* on Ashok's part to turn down a nice job around.

How many inches are there in a *foot*?

**Force** (n.) फ़ोर्स—1. जोर, ताक़त

Don't bang the door with great *force*.

(adv.) Please move *forward*.

(v.) 2. भेज देना, आगे बढ़ाना

Have you *forwarded* my application?

**Foul** (adj.) फ़ाउल—मैला, गन्दा, घृणित, बीभत्स

*Foul* smell emanated from the manhole.

**Found** (v.) फ़ाउन्ड—1. पाया, प्राप्त किया (Find का भूतकाल)

Have you *found* the book you had lost?

2. स्थापित करना, नींव डालना

Who *founded* your school?

(n.) The *foundation* stone of Lok Nayak Setu in Delhi was laid by the then Prime Minister Chandra Shekhar.

(*adj.*) Please open the *front* door.  
(*n.*) The *front* of my house faces a park.

**Frontier** (n.) फ्रंटियर—सरहद, सीमा  
Our *frontier* with Pakistan has been fenced in Punjab.

**Frown** (v. & n.) फ्राउन—भौंहे चढ़ाना, भ्रूभंग, तेवर, अप्रसन्नता प्रकट करना  
Why are you *frowning* at me ?  
We could tell by her *frown* that she was angry.

**Fruit** (n.) फ्रूट—1. फल  
Which is your favourite *fruit* ?  
2. परिणाम, नतीजा  
Good marks is the *fruit* of regular study.

**Fry** (v.) फ्राइ—तलना, भूनना  
I am *frying* fish.

**Fuel** (n.) फ्यूअल—ईंधन, जलावन  
We use petroleum gas for *fuel*.

**Fugitive** (n.) फ्यूजिटिव—फरारी, भगोड़ा  
The newspapers published the picture of the *fugitive* soldier.

**Fulfil** (v.) फुलफिल—पूरा करना, पालन करना  
I shall do my best to *fulfil* your expectations.

**Full** (adj.) फुल—पूर्ण, पूरा, भरा, पूरी तरह से, सीधे  
My room is *full* of books.  
Put a *full* stop at the end of each sentence.  
The water tank is *full*.  
(*adv.*) Only an honest person can look you *full* in the face.

**Fun** (n.) फन—मजाक, आमोद-प्रमोद  
We had a great *fun* at the party.

**Fund** (n.) फण्ड—निधि, कोष  
We have started a *fund* for the school building.

**Funeral** (n.) फ्यूनरल—मृतक-क्रिया, दफन, अन्त्येष्टि  
Did you attend the old man's *funeral* ?

**Funnel** (n.) फ़नल—कीप, चिमनी  
Use a *funnel* to fill kerosene in bottle.  
We could see the *funnel* of the approaching ship.



**Fur** (n.) फ़र्—लोम, समूर

I bought a *fur* coat during my visit to Kashmir.

**Furious** (adj.) फ़्युरिअस—भीषण, अति क्रुद्ध, उग्र

The manager became *furious* at the blunder of the clerk who sent an important letter to the wrong address.

**Furnace** (n.) फ़र्नेस—भट्टी

During a visit to the steel plant the students were shown a huge *furnace*.

**Furnish** (v.) फ़र्निश—प्रस्तुत करना, (ला) देना, सजाना

I would like to rent a *furnished* flat.

**Further** (adv.) फ़र्दर—1. और दूर

The climbers were too tired to move *further*.

(adj.) 2. और, अधिक, इससे अधिक

I have nothing *further* to say.

**Fury** (n.) फ़्युरि—प्रकोप, आवेश

Avoid the *fury* of the storm by remaining indoors.

**Fuse** (n.) फ़्यूज़—पसीज, बत्ती, फ़्यूज़

I want a *fuse* for my electric connection.

**Fuss** (n.) फ़स—बतंगड़, शोर शराबा

Don't make a *fuss* if there is no milk.

Don't be so *fussy* about your clothes.

**Future** फ़्यूचर—भावी, आगामी, भविष्यत्काल

(n.) In *future*, never hesitate to call me when you need help.

If you work hard, your *future* will be bright.

(adj.) What are your *future* plans?
