**Jab** (v.) जैब—चुभाना, कौंचना

**Jacket** (n.) जैकैट—जाकैट, मिरजई, आवरण

Please iron my *jacket*.

**Jagged** (adj.) जैगिड—1. काँटेदार, दाँतेदार

Be careful this saw has a *jagged* edge.

2. खुरदरे किनारों वाली

We can see *jagged* rocks on the sea coast.

**Jail** (n.) जेल—कैदखाना, कारागृह

How far is the local *jail* from here?

(v.) You can be *jailed* for rash driving.

**Jam** (n.) जैम—1. मुरब्बा

I want to buy a jar of apple *jam*.

2. भीड़

Ram somehow managed to reach station in time despite facing a long *traffic-jam*.

**Jar** (n.) जार्—मर्तबान

Please give me a *jar* of face cream.

(v.) 2. धक्का लगाना

I was badly *jarred* when my bicycle struck the fence.

(adj.) 3. कानों को बुरी लगने वाली

You should oil this door to stop its *jarring* sound.

**Jaw** (n.) जॉ—जबड़ा

I heard you had a fall and dislocated your *jaw*.

**Jealous** (adj.) जे'लस—ईर्ष्यालु

Don't be *jealous* of someone's achievements. Instead, try yourself to reach great heights.

**Jeer** जिअर्—उपहास (करना), ताना (मारना)

(n.) The daughter-in-law started crying as she was unable to tolerate the *jeers* of her mother-in-law.

(v.) If you want to be a good speaker, you must not be afraid of being *jeered* at.

**Jelly** (n.) जे'लि—जेली, अवलेह

My wife has set up a small unit for making jams and *jellies*.

**Jerk** (n.) जर्क—झटका, झटकना, झटका देना

When I heard a sound near my bed I got up with a *jerk*.

(v.) Don't *jerk* the steering wheel.

**Jest** जे'स्ट—मज़ाक, हँसी (करना)

(v.) Don't *jest* on Rakesh's accident as he hurt himself badly.

(n.) Please don't mind what I said in *jest*.

**Jewel** (n.) जूअल—रत्न, जवाहर

What is this *jewel* in your ring?

**Jingle** जिगल—छनक, छनकना, छनकाना

(n.) We heard the distant *jingle* of bells.

(adj.) The *jingling* sound in the street made the children run out of their home.

(v.) The young boy *jingled* the coins in his pocket.

**Job** (n.) जॉब—नौकरी, काम, कार्य

Did you get the *job* for which you had applied?

**Join** (v.) जॉइन—1. शामिल होना, भाग लेना

Would you like to *join* our party?

2. मिल जाना, जुड़ जाना

Does this lane *join* the main road?

3. जोड़ना, मिलाना, एकत्र/सम्बद्ध करना

Please *join* the two ends of the string.

**Joke** जोक—दिल्लगी, मज़ाक (करना)

(n.) If you tell good *jokes*, you will be popular at parties.

(v.) Please stop *joking* and be serious for a while.

**Jolly** (adj.) जॉलि—प्रसन्न, मिलनसार

Arun was liked by all because of his *jolly* nature.

**Jolt** जोल्ट—धक्का, झटका लगना

(n.) Passengers got a severe *jolt* when the bus stopped suddenly.

(v.) The news of my friend's accident *jolted* me badly.

**Jot** (v.) जॉट—1. (संक्षेप में) लिख देना

Have you *jotted* down the points of the speech you are going to make?

(n.) 2. तनिक भी

We don't care a *jot* what you say.

**Journal** (n.) जर्नल—पत्र, अखबार, पत्रिका

Many reputed companies publish their monthly house *journals*.

**Journey** (n. & v.) जर्नी—यात्रा/सफ़र (करना)

(n.) How much time will your *journey* to Madras take?

(v.) The pilgrims *journeyed* on foot from Delhi to Hardwar.

**Joy** (n.) जॉय—आनन्द, हर्ष

The children while watching the magic show were full of *joy*.

(adj.) Amit returned from the picnic in a *joyful* mood.

**Judge** (n. & v.) जेज—न्यायाधीश, पारखी, न्याय करना, आँकना

My uncle is a *judge* in the High Court. Never *judge* a man by his clothes.

**Jug** (n.) जेग—सुराही, घड़ा, जग

Please bring some cold water in a *jug*.

**Juice** (n.) जूस—रस

Would you like some *orange-juice*?

**Jumble** जैम्बल—अस्तव्यस्त कर देना, अव्यवस्था

(v.) Ramesh quickly wrote the correct words from the *jumbled* up words.

(n.) Human mind is a *jumble* of ideas.

**Jump** जम्प—कूद, छलाँग, कूदना, चौकना

(n.) I won a prize in high *jump*.

(v.) Don't *jump* to false conclusions.

**Junction** (n.) जंक्शन—1. संगम, मिलन

Be careful while driving through a *junction* of the main road with a lane.

2. जंक्शन

**Jungle** (n.) जंगल—जंगल, वन

My native place is a village on the edge of the *jungle*.

**Junior** (adj.) जून्यर—छोटा

By how many years is your brother *junior* to you?

**Just** जैस्ट—1. मात्र, भर, मुश्किल से

(adj.) The poor man had money *just* enough to buy a loaf of bread.

2. न्यायपूर्ण, वैध, उचित

The employer's decision to reward the laborious workers was *just*.

(n.) My father is known for his sense of *justice*.

(adv.) 3. तनिक

*Just* look at the rainbow in the sky.

4. अभी, तुरन्त

They are *just* going.

Hammer that nail *jutting* out from the chair.

**Juvenile** (adj.) जूविनाइल—तरुण, किशोर

You are now too old for such *juvenile* behaviour.
