Nap (n.) नैप—झपकी

Do you take a *nap* after lunch?

Napkin (n.) नैपकिन—नैपकिन

Please keep some *napkins* on the dinner table.

Narrow (adj.) नैरो—तंग, संकीर्ण

Can our car pass through a *narrow* lane?

Nasal (adj.) नेज़ल—नाक का

I have a cold, please give me some *nasal* drops.

Nasty (adj.) नास्टि—1. गन्दा, अप्रिय

This chemical has a *nasty* smell.

(adv.) Don't behave so *nastily*.

2. खतरनाक

There is a *nasty* bend in the road.

Nation (n.) नेशन—राष्ट्र, कौम, जाति

For the progress of mankind friendly ties between all *nations* are essential.

2. राष्ट्रियता

What is your *nationality*?

(adj.) I think you are acting in an *anti-national* manner.

Native (n.) नेटिव—मूल निवासी

Of what country is your foreign friend a *native*?

Nearly (adv.) निर्अलि—प्रायः, लगभग

My job is *nearly* finished.

Neat (adv.) नीट—साफ़-सुथरा, सुव्यवस्थित

You are very *neatly* dressed.

(adj.) His room is very *neat*.

Necessary (adj.) नेसेसरि—आवश्यक, जरूरी

If you want to score good marks it is *necessary* for you to study hard.

Neck (n.) नेक—गरदन

She has a beautiful long *neck*.

Necklace (n.) नेकलस—हार

This *necklace* will look more beautiful on a long neck.

Need नीड—आवश्यकता/अनिवार्यता (होना)

Need I go to the market immediately?

Notice (*n.*) नोटिस—1. सूचना, नोटिस

2. ध्यान

I smiled at Hari but he took no *notice*.

(*v.*) 3. देख लेना

I *noticed* that you had left the door open.

(*adj.*) The error was not *noticeable*.
