Quack (n.) क्वैक—1. नीम हकीम
Diseases can't be cured by *quack* remedies.

(v.) 2. काँ-काँ करना

Quadruped (n.) क्वाड्रूपड—चौपाया
A cow is a *quadruped*.

Quail (v.) क्वेल—काँपना
The convict *quailed* when he was sentenced.

Quaint (adj.) क्वेंट—निराला, अजीब
The old man's house was old and *quaint*.

I saw a *quaint* old lady.

Quake (v.) क्वैक—काँपना
You are *quaking* with cold.

Qualify (v.) क्वालिफ़ाई—1. योग्य होना
You do not *qualify* for this post.

(adj.) 2. प्रमाण-पत्र प्राप्त करना
Are you *qualified* as a doctor?

(n.) 3. योग्यता

What are your *qualifications*?

Quality (n.) क्वालिटी—1. किस्म, कोटि
This tea is not of good *quality*. Please change it.

2. गुण

Honesty is one of the *qualities* of an ideal businessman.

Quantity (n.) क्वाण्टिटी—मात्रा, परिमाण
Pearls are found in large *quantities* in this part of the sea.

Just add a small *quantity* of water to the medicine.

Quarantine (n.) क्वारन्टाइन—संग उठने-बैठने के लिए मनाही करना, संक्रामक रोगियों को दूसरों से मिलने-जुलने पर रोक लगाना

We may not see Umesh because he is in *quarantine*.

Quarrel क्वॉरल—झगड़ा (करना), कलह (करना)
(v.) The children are *quarrelling* about

who should have the red pen.

(n.) We don't know the cause of their quarrel.

Quarry क्वॉरि—1. खुली खान, खदान खोदना
(v.) Large quantities of slate are quarried in Wales.

(n.) 2. शिकार

The hunter followed his quarry for several hours.

Question (n.) क्वे'स्चन—1. प्रश्न, सवाल

I request you to answer my questions.

2. विचारणीय बात

The question is, how to live.

3. संदेह, संशय

Please accept my proposal without question.

(v.) 4. सवाल करना

I would like to question you.

Queue (n.) क्यू—1. पंक्ति, लाइन

Please stand in the queue.

Please take your place in the queue.

(v.) 2. लाइन लगाना

People queue at bus-stops.

Quick (adj.) क्विक—तेज, शीघ्रगामी, तत्काल

We should take quick decisions.

Rishi Raj has a very quick mind.

Be quick please. We don't have much time.

"Quick march", said the drill-master.

(adv.) Please don't walk quickly.

(v.) Try to quieten the child.

Quite (adv.) क्वाइट—बड़ा, नितांत, निश्चय ही

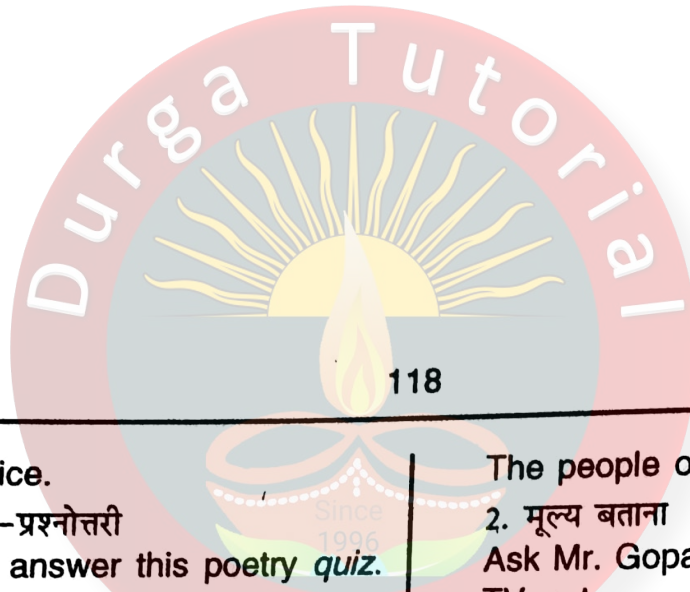
The orange was quite nice in taste.
